- 02 **Create quality face-to-face time.** Obviously, that can't be done in-person, but video chat platforms such as Zoom and Microsoft Teams offer a virtual way to do this. Remember the small talk.
- Manage expectations. Be clear what work expectations are. Do staff have goals and objectives? If those have changed given the pandemic, be sure to provide clear communication. Check in regularly for progress and planning sessions.
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- **Compassion.** For many that aren't used to working from home, the situation can feel isolating. Plan intentional check points and encourage team members to reach out to each other.
